## K Financial Foundation Update — 334 Pounds of Food Donated!

The K Financial team purchased a carload of canned soup, peas, chili and other items and delivered it to the Food Bank of the Rockies (FBR) on March 3, 2009. Our delivery weighed in at 334 pounds! After unpacking the goods and stacking it on pallets, the team joined an assembly line of inmates from a local prison that were on a work release program. We assembled and stamped boxes and the inmates loaded them with food. Several of them appeared to be good workers and expressed an interest in joining K Financial once they finish serving their time. The FBR serves as a distribution center for over 500 charitable organizations that feed the poor. Food is donated to FBR and then the eligible charities can go to their warehouse and “shop”. A minimal amount is charged on some items, but most of the food is given to the shoppers for free. FBR is a wonderful organization with an honorable mission.

In January, the K Financial team headed to downtown Denver to deliver breakfast and boxes of Girl Scout cookies to the homeless. In this tough economy, it is especially important to the Foundation to reach out to those who are struggling.
