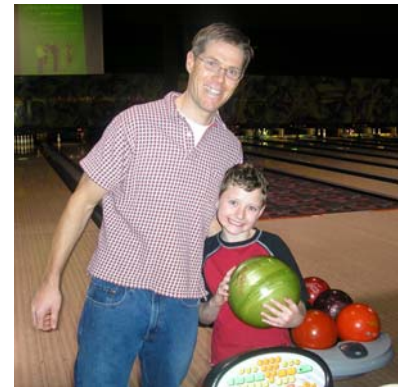
Pizza and Bowling with Mount Saint Vincent Home
